While Cyrus's brother, Adam was caught and tested successfully, Cyrus proved to be more wary, more anxious and I was not able to get a lead around her neck to bring her out of the enclosure for testing. However, she repeatedly approached, she showed no aggression or defensive behavior, other than running away when I brought out the lead.

After a while she did come close enough for me to reach out and scratch an ear or under he chin, but there was nothing to get hold of without hurting her.

My feeling is that while she is more skittish than Adam, she will come around and test similarly to Adam.
